The Starfish Story – Make a difference

Upon hearing the following inspiring story, we were convinced that little steps now will yield big results later. This acted as a trigger for the ACO Concept.

Loren Eiseley, while writing his book "The Unexpected Universe", was walking early one morning along the ocean side in Costabel. It was shortly after a storm had subsided and as he continued walking, he noticed that thousands of starfish had been washed up on the beach. Ahead of him was a gigantic rainbow of incredible perfection shimmering into existence. At the base of the rainbow stooped a little boy, gazing fixedly at an object in the sand. Eventually, he flung the object far beyond the breaking surf.

Eiseley went up to him and asked, "Son, what are you doing?" The little boy answered, "I'm throwing starfish back into the sea because if I don't they're going to die." "But there are thousands of starfish. In the larger scheme of things you're not going to make much of a difference to all these starfish." The little boy looked up at him, stooped down again to pick up another starfish and, gently but quickly, flung it back into the ocean. "It's going to make a big difference to that one" he replied.

Eiseley was embarrassed, uncomfortable with the contrast of the little boy's youthful, innocent love for the living with his own hardened, "mature" indifference to death. He had nothing to say and left,



continuing to walk on the beach but unable to get the picture of the little boy out of his mind. It was a moment of truth for Eiseley, of deep soul searching and self-confrontation. In time, he returned to the star thrower, silently picked up a starfish and spun it far out into the waves. "I understand." he said quietly. "Call me another thrower." Together, still under the hues of the rainbow, they spent hours throwing starfish back into the ocean. It was a task not assumed lightly, for it was men as well as starfish they sought to save, sensing intuitively that man cannot exist spiritually without life.

The same way a sponsor may not be able to make a big difference to the world by sponsoring one child. However he/she would be able to make a difference to that one child's life. With ACO, the difference we can make together will transform lives of underprivileged children. Not surprisingly we all together can make a difference to the world. Introduction to ACO

ACO (Adopt Child Online) is a non-profit, non-political organization run by Young and Energetic individuals, dedicated to empowering impoverished children by providing education to them and helping them become responsible citizens with the possibility of realizing and making their dreams come true.

The primary motive of ACO is to see to it that a child is not denied the right to education just because he is poor. There are several millions of children in our country who don't have access to good education due to a host of reasons. Whilst there are many people who wish that a part of their wealth be used to help the underprivileged, so in order to bridge this divide between the compassionate donors and deserving children, ACO identifies such children and gets them sponsored by such compassionate individuals. ACO thereby acts as an interface between the children and the sponsors and helps make all of this possible.

ACO was founded on 4th January 2010 with the dream of Eswar Reddy Maruri who faced many economic hurdles during his formative years because of poverty. Witness to difficulties, he wanted to make sure that no child, who is willing to study, is unable to do so due to the lack of funding. With a firm belief that education is the only way to empower the poor and with the intent to transform the world to help the poor children for their education, ACO was formed to act as an easy, reliable and transparent platform.

Why ACO


ACO strongly believes that education plays a major role in getting rid of poverty in India, by starting with surrounding localities. The premise here is that "Education will help put an end to dirty politics and will make this world a better place to live". Presently, conditions are such that



children cannot dream about education in good schools let alone a chance at a bright future. There are several reasons for the present condition and it makes perfect sense for us to start thinking about the solutions rather than worrying about the problems. ACO is attempting to offer one of the solutions to these problems.

Many individuals are willing to sponsor one or more children and help them get better education. However, for a willing sponsor transparency is as important as donation itself. There is ample scope for such a model to flourish given that ACO offers a transparent mechanism. So, there is a need for simple, accessible, reliable and transparent system which chooses the right children, sends them to good schools and continuously follows-up with their progress and provides updates to the sponsor. ACO is such organization that ensures this efficiency and transparency and possibilities to the Sponsors and Children.

Adopt Child Online is a web-based children education sponsorship program

Sponsor is the one who supports the child education in the form of funding.



Choosing the child

An underprivileged child can be chosen anywhere from India. ACO will verify the background of the child and see if the child is eligible for sponsorship. Once the child is chosen by ACO, all the information about the child will be displayed on the ACO website. ACO will look for eligible sponsors who will support the child's education. Once the sponsor is available, we enroll them at good schools. With proper education, ACO is going to open a life full of opportunities to the child.

Timeline of Sponsorship

ACO is going to look for a sponsor only for a certain period of time during a child's education cycle. Sponsor need not take care of the entire education of a child if he chooses to. A period ranging from 1 year, 2 years, 4 years according to the commitment from the sponsor. Once the committed period is over, ACO will look for another sponsor if the current sponsor is unable to continue sponsorship.


Follow-up Mechanism

ACO will follow-up with the school faculty, guardians/parents to know child's continuous progress. ACO will prepare a check list for the same through which we can analyze the child's progress statistically. Also, ACO will request sponsors to speak to the child about their educational progress and encourage them.

The Concept of Virtual Adoption

Every human being has the heart to help an underprivileged child. Once the sponsors support a child's education, ACO is going to create a platform where the sponsor feels the adoption of a child virtually. With every bit of child information provided online (on ACO website) and continuous updates about the child, the sponsor is going to experience great self-satisfaction with the virtual adoption. With that self-less feeling of awakened humanity with-in, the sponsor is not going to be the same person again.

This way ACO not only unlocks the intellectual potential of a child but also awakens the humanitarian in the average citizen. ACO is not only succeeding in providing education to a child but also delivering a humanitarian. ACO strongly believes that it is very important to the society.



Virtual Adoption Concept

Transparency of Organizational Activities and Funds

Transparency in organizational funds, organizational activities are very important and ACO uses technology and web-based approach and near real time processing to achieve this.

Organizational Activities

Each and every activity of ACO will be transparent and all ACO members will be informed through E-mails. A group called acoindia@googlegroups.com contain e-mail ID's of all sponsors and members. All activities are shared with this group and everyone in this group has access to send/receive any information.

Organizational Funds / Transparency

- ⇒ ACO will provide all the necessary bills (fee receipts etc.,) to the sponsor along with assurance certificate.
- ⇒ All transactions will be done through ACO Society Account
- ⇒ All funds raised/expenditure for ACO will be displayed on the website
- ⇒ Expense report is shared to all ACO members after every ACO activity
- ⇒ Every year the Annual Financial report / Balance Sheet will be displayed on the ACO website



Information available on the Website/Online

- ⇒ The Child and Sponsor information (Only with sponsor approval)
- ⇒ All Contributions made to ACO will be put on the website.
- ⇒ Founders contact information is available on the website.
- ⇒ Annual Financial reports will be uploaded to the website
- ⇒ ACO provides a web login account to the sponsor. Sponsor can login to the website and find his/her adopted child status. ACO is going to provide the following information online to the sponsor:
 - Child Photograph, Schooling Information
 - Contact Number and Address of the child
 - Financial Background, Parental Background
 - Passions and Goals of a child
 - Quarterly Progress reports
